## ADMISSION NOTIFICATION FOR M.Phil IN LAW TEACHING & RESEARCH PROGRAMME 2016

Applications are invited in prescribed proforma for admission to M.Phil in Legal teaching & Research programme for the session 2016-17. The programme is of one & half year duration.

### About NLUO

National Law University Odisha, Cuttack was established by Act-IV of 2008 by the Odisha State Legislature. It is offering five year integrated programme of B.A. LL.B (Honours), B.B.A LL.B (Honours), LL.M and Ph.D programmes. It has a sprawling campus of 50 acres bound by the scenic beauty of the river Mahanadi in the South and Kathjodi in the North. The Chancellor of the University is the Chief Justice of Orissa High Court and the Visitor of the University is the Chief Justice of India or his nominee Judge of the Supreme Court.

NLUO encourages quality research and scholarship in contemporary areas in both theoretical and practical research with a holistic prospective.

### Eligibility Criteria

1. An applicant seeking admission to M.Phil programme must have: Master's Degree in Law from any recognized University securing not less than 55% marks or its equivalent in grade; or

### No of Seats

Total no of seats in M.Phil programme – 10

NLUO will follow all mandatory provisions in the reservation policy of the Government of India. Admission to M.Phil programme will be made purely on the basis of merit following the prescribed criteria of the University.

University reserves the right to fill or not to fill all or any of the seats.

### Selection Procedure

1. Submitted application forms will to be screened, and candidates found eligible will be required to appear for an entrance examination on Monday, **June 27, 2016** in NLUO campus only.

2. Successful and exempted candidates are required to appear before a panel of experts for a personal Interview.
3. Selected candidates will be notified and intimated.

### **Entrance Test:**

The Entrance Test shall consist of two stages.

#### **First Stage**

Entrance Examination for **150 marks** (Objective test of 100 marks and subjective test of 50 marks.) of 2 hours duration.

The syllabus of the objective paper shall cover:

##### **A. Research Aptitude**

Research; Meaning, Characteristics and Types, Steps of Research, Methods of Research, Research Ethics, Sources, Acquisition and Interpretation of Data, Quantitative and Qualitative Data, Graphical Representation and Mapping of Data

##### **B. Constitutional Law of India**

Preamble, Fundamental Rights and Duties, Directive Principles of State Policy, Judiciary, Parliament and State Legislature, Amendment of the Constitution, Writ Jurisdiction

##### **C. Legal Theory**

Nature and Sources of Law, Positivism, Natural Law Theory, Sociological Jurisprudence, Theories of Punishment, Rights and Duties, Concept and Possession and Ownership

The subjective questions will be testing the Legal Teaching Aptitude of the Candidate.

#### **Second Stage**

Personal Interview (50 Marks) by an Interview Panel decided by the University.

#### **Qualifying Criteria**

The candidates need to secure 50% Marks in the entrance test in order to qualify for the stage of Personal Interview.

The final selection of the candidates for the M.Phil degree programme shall be made on the basis of the performance in the Interview.

#### **Stipend**

Selected Candidates will be given a stipend of Rs. 15,000/- per month.

## **Instructions to Candidates**

Applicants are required to submit the following:

1. Completed application form
2. Three copies of a brief write up on Law Teaching & Research in India and Intention to become Law Teacher & Researcher to be justified.
3. A demand draft of Rs. 3000/- drawn in favour of “Registrar National Law University Odisha”
4. Attested photocopies of eligibility qualification certificates and mark sheets;
5. A passport size photograph.
