Brief Biography about Speaker:

Prof. Prabhat Patnaik is a Professor Emeritus, at the Centre for Economic Studies and Planning in the School of Social Sciences at Jawaharlal Nehru University in New Delhi. Prof. Prabhat Patnaik is an Indian economist and political commentator, who has achieved international acclaim with his incisive analyses of economics and politics.

He was born in Jatni Orissa, educated in Delhi and then earned his highest degrees from Oxford University with prestigious Rohde's Scholarship. He was associated with University of Cambridge, teaching Economics and politics and headed the Sukhamoy Chakravarty Chair in Planning and Development at Centre for Economic Studies, Jawaharlal Nehru University (JNU).

His specialization is Macroeconomics and Political Economy, areas in which he has written a number of books and articles. His books include Time, Inflation and Growth (1988), Economics and Egalitarianism (1990), Whatever Happened to Imperialism and Other Essays (1995), Accumulation and Stability Under Capitalism (1997), and The Retreat to Unfreedom (2003). He has been the editor of Social Scientist, which under his stewardship has become a highly effective vehicle for progressive ideas and fertile research and has been Vice-Chairman of the Kerala State Planning Board.
