NOTICE: DECISION ON RAGGING COMPLAINTS

Notice No: NLUO/Notice/ARC/001

To all University Members,

This correspondence serves to inform you of the decisions made during the meeting of the Anti-Ragging Committee, as per the provisions of Regulations 6.3 of the UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009. The meeting took place on October 30, 2023.

During the meeting, the Committee reviewed and deliberated upon the report submitted by the Anti-Ragging Squad in reference to Complaint No. AR/01/2023 and AR/02/2023, wherein a formal complaint was filed against a student to have committed the act of ragging. His act of ragging includes the wrongful act of extortion and criminal intimidation.

The Committee arrived at unanimous consensus on the findings of the Anti-Ragging Squad pertaining to Complaint No. AR/01/2023 and AR/02/2023. It was established that the student is found to have committed the act of ragging. His act of ragging includes wrongful act of causing bodily injury and criminal intimidation.

In light of these findings, the Anti-Ragging Committee has recommended and approved the following sanctions to be imposed against the student. The Committee unanimously recommends:

- a. Immediate Eviction from NLUO Hostels:** The student shall not be permitted to stay in the NLUO hostels for the remaining duration of their course at NLUO, effective immediately.
- b. Participation Restrictions:** The student shall not be permitted to participate in or represent NLUO in any extra-curricular or academic events, whether within or outside the University.
- c. Membership Restrictions:** The student shall not be allowed to hold membership in any student committee or society within the University.
- d. Termination of Current Memberships:** All current memberships held by the student in any student committee or society shall be terminated with immediate effect.

These measures are taken in accordance with the seriousness of the offense and with the intention of maintaining a safe and respectful environment within our institution.

We expect full compliance with these directives, and any failure to do so will be met with further disciplinary actions.

This decision is effective immediately and is to be strictly adhered to by all concerned parties. Any violation of these directives will be subject to further disciplinary action.

We expect all members of the University community to uphold the principles of respect and dignity, and to contribute to maintaining a safe and inclusive environment for all.
