In view of the good number of candidates applied, Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor has constituted the three members Screening Committee to shortlist the candidates for Associate Professor of Law, Assistant Professor of Law and Research Associate cum Teaching Assistant. The committee has adopted the following criteria to shortlist the Candidates:

**1) Criteria for Associate Professor of Law**

- a) Good Academic record with Ph.D. Degree in Law,
- b) LL.M. Degree with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed)
- c) A minimum of 8 years of teaching and/or research experience with a minimum of 5 publications as books and/or research/policy papers as prescribed by UGC Regulation 2010
- d) Contribution to educational innovation etc. as prescribed by UGC Regulation 2010
- e) A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS), set out by UGC Regulation 2010

**2) Criteria for Assistant Professor of Law**

- a) Good Academic record with at least 55% marks in LL.M. (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed)
- b) UGC NET and/or Ph.D. as prescribed by UGC Regulation 2010
- c) Other things being equal, preference is given to candidates who have minimum one year of teaching experience in Law from reputed institutions and have specialisation in the following areas.
  - i. Taxation
  - ii. Company Law
  - iii. Transfer of Property
  - iv. International Trade Law
  - v. Constitutional Law
  - vi. Environmental Law
  - vii. IPR

**3) Criteria for Research Associate cum Teaching Assistant**

- a) Good Academic record with at least 55% marks in LL.M. (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed)
- b) Candidates having LL.M. Degree from reputed institutions and got their degree in the session starting from 2011-12
- c) Other things being equal, preference is given to candidates who have specialisation in the following areas:
  - i) Taxation
  - ii) Company Law
  - iii) Transfer of Property
  - iv) International Trade Law
  - v) Constitutional Law
  - vi) Environmental Law
  - vii) IPR
