5	<p>To consider the approval of Starting “M.Phil. in Law Teaching and Research”</p> <p>There is concern at national level that National Law Universities have not been able to produce Postgraduates willing to take up teaching responsibilities. Hence, there is a shortage of competent law teachers in the country. In this regard, NLUO proposes to start “M.Phil. in Law Teaching & Research. It will be one year duration programme starting from the Academic year 2014-15. It is proposed that they will pay tuition fee of Rupees One lakh. They will be paid monthly stipend of Rs. 15000/- for twelve months. They will be taught teaching methods & research methodology extensively. The M.Phil. candidates have to work under experienced teachers. The allocation will be done by the Vice Chancellor in consultation with Academic Coordination Committee. The M.Phil. candidates will have to prepare course outline, teaching plan for 65 hours & compile reading materials in at least 3 subjects of their interest. They have to assist the teachers to whom they are allotted for teaching. They have to prepare write ups on the cases and materials in the said 3 subjects of their choice. They will have to submit one dissertation relating to</p>	Approved.

It is submitted that learning of Undergraduate studies as well as Postgraduate studies be liked to these centres. A student has to work in 10 Semesters in 10 centres of their choice. This is going to bring a blend of service to the people in need of legal services & business related laws, practical learning.

2. **There are 8 seminar courses** taught at present. These seminar courses will have emphasis on the application of laws to the real situations. For example, a student doing a seminar course on Child Right will be appearing before the Juvenile Justice Court under the supervision of their teachers & the panel of University Advocate working for legal aid centres. Similarly, they will also take up research work relating to child labours in various sectors of the industry or they may do some research on children in need of care & protection by visiting the organisations implementing the same.

A student taking of contract law and management seminar course will be required to go through the some of the contracts relating to infrastructure or sale of machinery or goods etc. and analyse the way it has been drafted and any improvement that may be incorporated. Students will also be required to draft some contracts under the supervision of the teachers.

In order to facilitate this efforts are being made to establish contact with Infrastructure Development Corporation of Odisha (IDCO) and other industries situated in Odisha.

It is also been proposed to develop collaboration with prosecution departments of Odisha & many more departments involved in implementation of law so that good number of seminar courses may be offered as

	<p>optional. Course Evaluation: Four practical courses of BCI will be taught with emphasis on practice of law. The research project will be more of empirical research facilitated by the Legal Service Clinics, which are 8 in number.</p> <p>3. The placement of students with lawyer's offices, law firms & companies will be streamlined and strengthened. It will be compulsory from 3rd year onwards facilitated by the University. Each Undergraduate student will have to do a minimum of 35 days placement in a year. The official placement of the University will start from the 2nd week of November to 24th of December. It will come to about 45days total after deleting the Sundays. The details as to the work to be done and documentation will be circulated on 17th May 2014. The Evaluation will be of 30 Marks for 3rd year placements, 30 Marks for 4th Year placement & 40 Marks for 5th year placement all put together a full course of 100 marks will be evaluated. 8	<p>To Consider Attendance Policy In this residential University, students should have minimum 75% attendance for examination. 75% does not include medical leave or un-official representation of the University or un-official placements. In case student falls short off 75 % attendance, approval is requested for remedial classes depending on the maximum shortage of in any given subject. Hence, it is also proposed that students will have to pay Rs. 5000/- per subject. This amount is suggested keeping in mind there has to be deterrence for absenting the classes. They will have to write the examination immediately after the completion of remedial classes.</p>	<p>After due deliberations the AC approved that remedial classes may be conducted only for those students who have at least 50% attendance. Those who have less than 50% attendance will have to detain in the interest of strengthening the academics and learning.</p>
10	<p>Any other item with the permission of the Chair.</p>	<p>The NLSIU, Bangalore Vice-Chancellor Prov. R. Venkato Rao moved a resolution highly appreciating the proposal to start M. Phil in Law teaching and Research. The first of its kind in the country. This will go a long way in producing competent law teachers which is the need of the country today. He also proposed the resolution appreciating remedial classes in case of attendance shortage as approved earlier. The Academic Council Members unanimously supported the resolution and recorded appreciation for the initiative taken by the Vice-Chancellor and his team.</p>
