Action Taken Report (ATR) based on the plan of action decided upon at the beginning of the year

1. Infrastructure

In Infrastructure facility, construction of second girls hostel has progressed. Two blocks out of four blocks with 90 rooms have been constructed and have been occupied. Other two blocks would be constructed in due course and the library would be completed soon depending on the availability of financial assistance.

2. Research and Publication

(a) Faculty members of the University have received fellowship for summer school and Research abroad. Prof. (Dr.) Sri Krishna Deva Rao has received Fulbright Nehru International Education Administrators Seminar Fellowship for 2018-19. Dr. Rangin Pallav Tripathi has got Fulbright Fellowship for Post-Doc Research in Harvard Law School. Mr. Pallab Das has got Scholarship for Summer School on International Commercial Arbitration and European Crisis.
