NLUO has performed remarkably well in many national level moot court competitions including NUJS HSF National Corporate Law Moot, NLIU - Justice R.K. Tankha Memorial International Arbitration Moot, NALSAR UNHCR Public International Law Moot Court Competition, Oxford Monroe E Price Media Moot Court Competition, Ian Fletcher International Insolvency Moot Court Competition and ICC Moot Court Competition . Students have received accolades time and again in some of the most prestigious moot court competitions.

NLUO's FLAGSHIP MOOT

International Maritime Arbitration Moot (IMAM)



Since its inception, the Moot Society has successfully organised eleven editions of its flagship moot court competition 'International Maritime Arbitration Moot (IMAM)'. NLUO-IMAM is the first moot court competition in India and the third moot court competition in the world having maritime law as its principal subject matter. Maritime law was chosen as the subject matter considering Odisha's rich maritime history and tradition.

Over the years, NLUO-IMAM has seen splendid participation from teams representing premier law schools across India. Additionally, NLUO-IMAM also receives participation from several universities across the globe. The Moot Society hosts the most acclaimed judges in the field of maritime law and arbitration worldwide. NLUO-IMAM is prospering because of the quality and effort behind the Moot Propositions, the profile of the judges of the competition and the competitiveness displayed by the participating teams.



The 11th Edition of National Law University Odisha Bose & Mitra & Co. International Maritime Arbitration Moot 2024 (IMAM) - the flagship mooting event of NLU Odisha, and one of the most prestigious Maritime Arbitration Moot Court Competitions across the country was organized from 14-17 March 2024. For the 11th edition of IMAM, we carried out successful collaborations with Bose & Mitra & Co. as our 'Title Sponsor'; The Institute of International Shipping and Trade Law (IISTL), Swansea University, the United Kingdom as our 'Strategic Partner, with Informa Law as our 'Knowledge Partner', SCC Online- EBC as our "Exclusive Media Partner" and the Asian Institute of Alternative Dispute Resolution (AIADR) as our 'Resource Partner'. The Awards for 11th IMAM 2024 were sponsored by Bose & Mitra & Co., and the Case Study for the competition was drafted by IISTL, Swansea University. Intra University Moot Court Competition



The Moot Society facilitates students' selections for representing NLUO in various national and international moot court competitions through the organisation of the annual Intra University Moot Court Competitions (IUMCC). Every student, irrespective of their year, can participate in IUMCC.

During its current tenure, The Moot Society conducted the 15th IUMCC in September 2023. There was participation from around 340 students from across the batches in the IUMCC.

The problem of 15th IUMCC was drafted by Mr. Satish Padhi and Mr. Jubin Jay, who are the alumni of National Law University Odisha. They work in a law firm based out of New Delhi.
