

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES- CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

1. The participants are requested to submit an abstract of a maximum of 300–500 words.
2. The submission must be made in Microsoft Word (.docx) format through the Google form, which shall be released by the Centre.
3. The submission should adhere to the following formatting style:
 - a. Font: Times New Roman
 - b. Font size: 12
 - c. Line spacing: 1.5"
 - d. Margin: 1"
4. The abstract shall contain:
 - a. Title of the proposed article
 - b. A minimum of 5 references (shall be exclusive of the word limit)
 - c. A concise overview covering the aims, approach, key results, and significance of the work
5. Co-authorship is allowed subject to a maximum of 02 authors.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES- CALL FOR PAPERS

1. The submission must be in the form of a descriptive, analytical, or critical analysis of the particular subject matter, reflecting original and unpublished work that is not under review on any other platform.
2. A maximum similarity of 15% is permitted. Non-adherence to this originality requirement shall result in the rejection of the work summarily without any chance of revision.
3. The submission should ideally be limited to a length of 3,000 to 5,000 words.
4. Submissions must be made in Microsoft Word (.docx) format through the Google form, which shall be released by the Centre.
5. The submission should adhere to the following formatting style:
 - a. Font: Times New Roman
 - b. Font size: 12

- c. Line spacing: 1.5"
 - d. Margin: 1"
- 6. For Footnotes:
 - a. Font: Times New Roman
 - b. Font size: 10
 - c. Line spacing: 1"
- 7. Relevant sources must be properly cited, adhering to the uniform Bluebook 4th Edition citation style.
- 8. An article may be authored by a maximum of two co-authors.
- 9. The Editorial Board of Centre for Banking & Insurance Laws (CBIL) shall retain all copyrights arising out of any publications.
