The Child Protection Mentorship program is an online learning initiative designed specifically for early and mid-career development professionals working in the State of Odisha who seek to build a career in the child protection sector. This program aims to strengthen the required skills and knowledge of participants by offering in-depth insights into child protection issues, legal frameworks, and effective strategies to safeguard children in their communities.

Program Objectives

- Build an understanding on the key concepts, legal frameworks and policies related to child protection practice
- Develop skills, attitude, tools and techniques essential for working with children, families and stakeholders involved in the child protection ecosystem
- Promote child-centered programs, policy implementations and interventions.
