Sir,

With reference to your letter No. NLUO/VCO/19/10 dated 29.05.2010 on the above subject. I am directed to say that National Law University, Orissa has been established by an Act (No.4 of 2008) of State Legislature of Orissa as a State University and empowered to award degrees as specified by the UGC under section 22 of the UGC Act 1956 through its main campus with the approval of statutory bodies/councils, wherever required.

University is not allowed to start any off-campus centre beyond the territorial jurisdiction of the State as per Supreme Court Jugement in Prof. Yash Pal vs State of Chattisgarh case Private franchise is not permitted.

The University may note and adhere to the following:-

- To ensure that no off campus centre(s)/study centre are opened by the University outside the territorial jurisdiction of the State in view of the judgement of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in case of Prof. Yash Pal vs. State of Chhattisgarh.
- ii) In case the university has already started any off-campus/study centre and the centre operating through franchises inside/outside the State, it must be closed immediately.
- No distance education programmes shall be started without the prior approval of Distance Education Council, New Delhi, which is the regulatory body for distance education.
- iv) The University shall follow UGC (Minimum Standards and Procedure for award of M.Phil/Ph.D Degree) Regulations, 2009 & other UGC Regulations issued from time to time & posted on UGC website www.ugc.ac.in.
