



Valedictory Event of the Child Protection Mentorship Program (CPMP) 2025

The Centre for Child Rights (CCR) at the National Law University Odisha (NLUO), in collaboration with UNICEF, offered a Child Protection Mentorship Program (CPMP) from July to December 2025. The initiative was aimed to build a committed cadre of child protection and allied practitioners equipped with the knowledge, skills, attitude and ethical grounding necessary to respond to the contemporary and complex challenges faced by children from vulnerable socio-economic contexts across Odisha. Conceived as an online professional development program, it was designed specifically for early and mid-career development professionals working in the State of Odisha who seek to build a career in the child protection sector. The mentorship program engaged over 100 participants through 32 online sessions led by 12 external and 3 NLUO mentors, focusing on child protection laws, policies, and practical skills for working with children. For marking the formal conclusion of the program, a valedictory event has been scheduled. The event aims to acknowledge the participants engagement and provide a platform for shared reflections on the mentorship journey and the way forward.
