The undertaking/cover letter must provide details about the author/s along with the undertaking regarding originality and fact that the manuscript has not been published elsewhere. Undertaking/cover letter must be signed by the author/s and scanned copy must be sent on the given mail. Given below is the word limit for the different categories of writings.
