Centre for Disability Law and Advocacy of National Law University Odisha, Cuttack invites original unpublished papers for **edited volume on Protection to Persons with disabilities - Challenges and Solutions**. The papers should include a comprehensive analysis of the issues being dealt with. They may be the result of either doctrinal or empirical research and provide an in-depth understanding of the issue covered under the topic. Comparative studies outlining the similarities as well as the contrasting features of different systems of law are also welcome.

Eligibility:

We welcome submissions from academicians, faculty members and researchers having expertise in this area to come up with their contributions in the form of well researched articles. All the papers would be reviewed and checked on anti-plagiarism software.

Word limit:

Contributions in the form of articles should be **between 5000 and 7000 words (excluding footnotes)**. Under rare circumstance, an analysis of a recent landmark judgement written in the form of an article may be considered. All submissions must include **an abstract of 300 to 350 words**.

Broad themes for submission:

We invite original unpublished articles that may address one or more of the following themes:

- The Current Laws, Policies and Implementation Challenges in Developing Countries

- Disability and Role of the State and Private Parties
- Disability and Non-discrimination
- Disability and Issues of Accessibility
- Disability and Access to Healthcare
- Disability, Equality of Opportunity and Employment
- Disability and Social Security
- Disability and Sports
- Mental Health and Disability Benefits
- Disability Advocacy

Note: Authors are free to choose any topic relating to Disability Law. The above mentioned broad areas and themes are for elucidatory purpose.
