

Past work done by the Centre for Consumer Law (CCL):

1. After the introduction of the new Consumer Protection Act, 2019, the Centre for Consumer Law, National Law University Odisha has been actively assisting the State Government of Odisha to come up with the updated State Consumer Protection Bill. The Centre is in constant touch with the Minister of Food Supply and Consumer Welfare Department, Odisha Government, and other prominent consumer protection activists of the country regarding the same. The Centre has come up with Draft Rules for the State which has been submitted to the concerned department for implementation.
2. Taking advantage of the virtual college a National level webinar was organized by the Centre in association with the Food Supplies and Consumer Welfare Department, Government of Odisha on 5th December 2020 on the topic “Consumer Protection 2019 as a Landmark statute for the protection of Consumers” to spread awareness among the students regarding the same.
3. With regards to the draft rules on Consumer Protection Act, 2019 the Centre also conducted a two-day workshop on the topic “Consumer Welfare: Framing of draft rules on Consumer Protection Act, 2019” at Conference Hall of National Law University Odisha on 25th October 2019.
4. A two-days Certificate Course on Consumer Justice in the Era of Globalization was organized by the Centre in collaboration with the Chair on Consumer Law & Practice, NLSIU, Bengaluru on 2nd and 3rd April 2019.
5. In the academic year, 2018-19 the Centre organized and successfully conducted the “1st Intra-University Essay Writing Competition”. A cash prize was also awarded to the winners.
6. The Centre in the past has also organised a guest lecture by Shri. S.P Mishra, Chairperson, Indian Institute of Public Administration (IIPA) on “Consumer Protection in India.”
