The National Law University Odisha invites quotations from **well established**, **reputed and financially sound**, **eligible Service Providers(with experience of** *similar service)* **to provide services of Counseling & Mental Wellness for its stakeholders in Two (02) Bid system (Technical & Financial respectively).** The contract is initially for a period of **02 (Two) Years**, and extendable up to **05 (Five)** years with mutual consent on satisfactory performance with the same rate or till finalization of next Tender, whichever is later.

Name of Service: Providing Counseling & Mental Wellness Service to NLUO Cuttack.

- 1. The quantum of service to be executed during 01(One) year is estimated to cost of approximately **Rs.12**, **00**,**000**/- (Rupees **Twelve Lakh** only). The estimate, however, is given merely as a rough guide, which may go up or may be below as per the actual requirement of the University from time to time.
- 2. Intending Bidders are eligible to submit their bid provided they have definite proof from the appropriate authority, which shall be to the satisfaction of the competent authority of having satisfactorily completed similar services. - 24*7*365 counseling/support and availability for the students through Video Conferencing, Telephonic and Chat mode whichever is required.
- One Webinar/Seminar/Workshop per month for students/faculty/staff relating to the Mental Health, Sexual Harassment etc. by experts.
- Availability of qualified therapist, psychologist/psychiatrist/counselor on 24*7*365 as and when required.
- Telephonic availability of psychiatrist and psychologists to students in vacations for continuance of therapy sessions.
- Counselors specially trained in dealing with Stress management and suicidal tendencies in early adults.
- Other allied mental health expertise

17. General Conditions -

- i. The agreement shall commence from the first day of subsequent month after award /sign of the contract or as mutual agreed upon and shall continue till completion of two years unless it is terminated by the authority with one month notice, owing to unsatisfactory performance or change in requirement.

In case termination of this Agreement on its expiry or otherwise, the persons deployed by the Service Provider shall not be entitled to and shall have no claim for any type of absorption in regular or other capacity.
- viii. Losses caused to the University due to negligence/lapses/denigration on the part of Service Provider will be recovered from the Agency/Service Provider.
 - ix. The selected agency shall have to execute an agreement on non-judicial stamp paper of ₹100/-[or of applicable amount] which will be signed by both the parties in the presence of two witnesses from both the parties.
 - x. After awarding the service contract, if the Agency fails to provide the desired level of service on the target date/time, the offer of contract will automatically stand cancelled without any notice and the total security amount will be forfeited.

- xviii. If any loss or damage caused to the University by the persons engaged, the same shall be recovered from the unpaid bills or adjusted from the Performance Security Deposit deposited by the Agency.

- xxi. All liabilities arising out of accident or death while on duty shall be borne by the agency.
- xxii. The University does not bind itself to accept lowest or any other conditions. The authorities of National Law University, Cuttack reserves the right to reject or accept any or all the quotations with or without assigning any reason there to.
- xxiii. The successful bidder shall provide the complete profile of all the Personnel associated with them for the service to be provided. This should be provided to the University for record within 15 (Fifteen) days of the issue of the service order/contract.
- xxiv. For complaint, of non-adherence of terms and condition specified in quotation call document, indiscipline and unsatisfactory level of Service noticed by University Officials a penalty of up to 5% of monthly bill may be levied after the approval of Authorities of NLUO on every event.
- xxv. Payment of the bill shall be released on monthly basis after receiving a satisfactory duty completion/performance report of the concerned Designated Officer/In-charge of the University. The Agency should submit its bill in the first week of every month along with proof of sessions conducted / reports of sessions and the payment for this will be released to the Agency, within 02(Two) weeks from the date of submission of the bill.
- xxvi. TDS and other taxes as applicable will be deducted from the Agency's bill as per Govt. instructions from time to time.
- xxvii. The Lowest Bidder will be decided as per the Computation Rates quoted by the Bidder for all the items.
- xxviii. The Agency shall be solely responsible for compliance to the provisions of various Labour and industrial laws, such as, wages, allowances, compensations, EPF, Bonus. Or In Case of breach of any terms and conditions as mentioned above, the Competent Authority, will have the right to reject the bid at any stage without assigning any reason thereof and nothing will be payable by NLUO, Cuttack in that event the EMD/Security amount shall also stands forfeited.
- **19.Termination of Contract**: NLUO, Cuttack would have the right to terminate the contract by giving one month's notice before the expiry of the term, in case the service performance is notup to the standard, or in case there is any violation of NLUO, Cuttack rules & regulations, or if there is any lapse in compliance of any labour legislation, or if there is any incident of indiscipline on the part of the Bidder or his staff and the agreement may be terminated by either party by giving one month's notice to the institution. The contract shall be governed by laws and procedures established by Govt. of India, within the frame work of applicable legislation and enactment made from time to time concerning such commercial dealings/ processing.

22. Force Majeure:

- Notwithstanding the provisions of GCC clauses, the bidder shall not be liable for, forfeiture of its performance security, liquidated damages or termination for default, if and to the extent that its delay in performance or other failure to perform its obligations under the contract is the result of an event of Force Majeure
- For purpose of this clause, "Force Majeure" means an event beyond the control of the bidder and not involving the supplier's fault or negligence and not foreseeable. Such events may include, but are not restricted to, acts of the bidder in its sovereign capacity, was or revolutions, fires, floods, epidemics, quarantine restrictions and freight embargoes.
