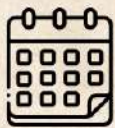

He has been a firm advocate for freedom of speech and the right to criticise constitutional functionaries for which he famously faced a contempt of court conviction. He is also the author of the best-selling book named “The Case that Shook India” based on *Indira Gandhi v. Raj Narain*, a case that decisively shaped India’s political destiny. Recently, he has been active in litigating the legality of the SIR process.”
